MUST-VISIT PLACES IN LEH-LADAKH

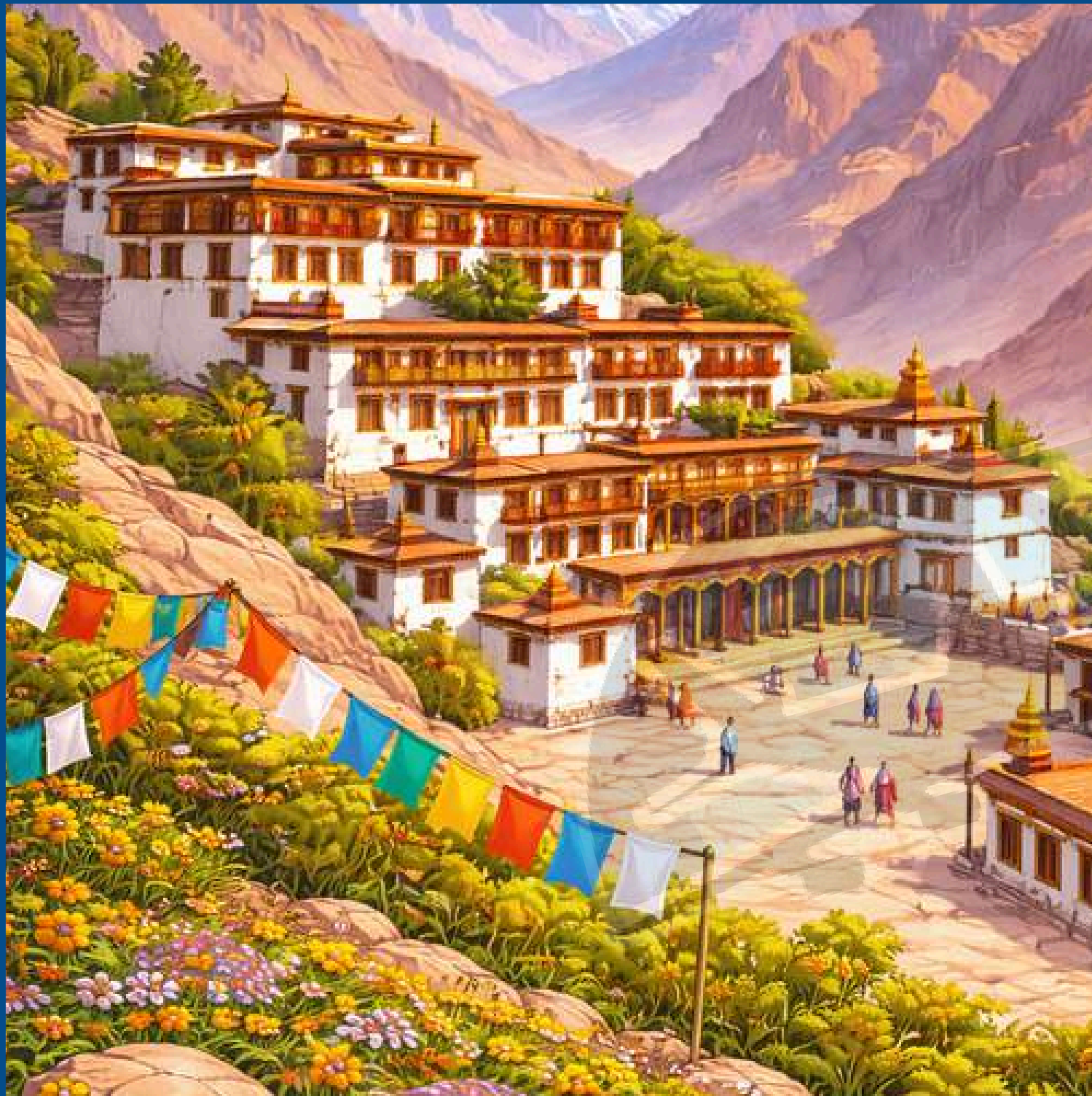
Leh - The main town, known for Leh Palace, local markets, and mountain views.

Hemis Monastery - One of the largest monasteries in Ladakh, known for festivals and culture.

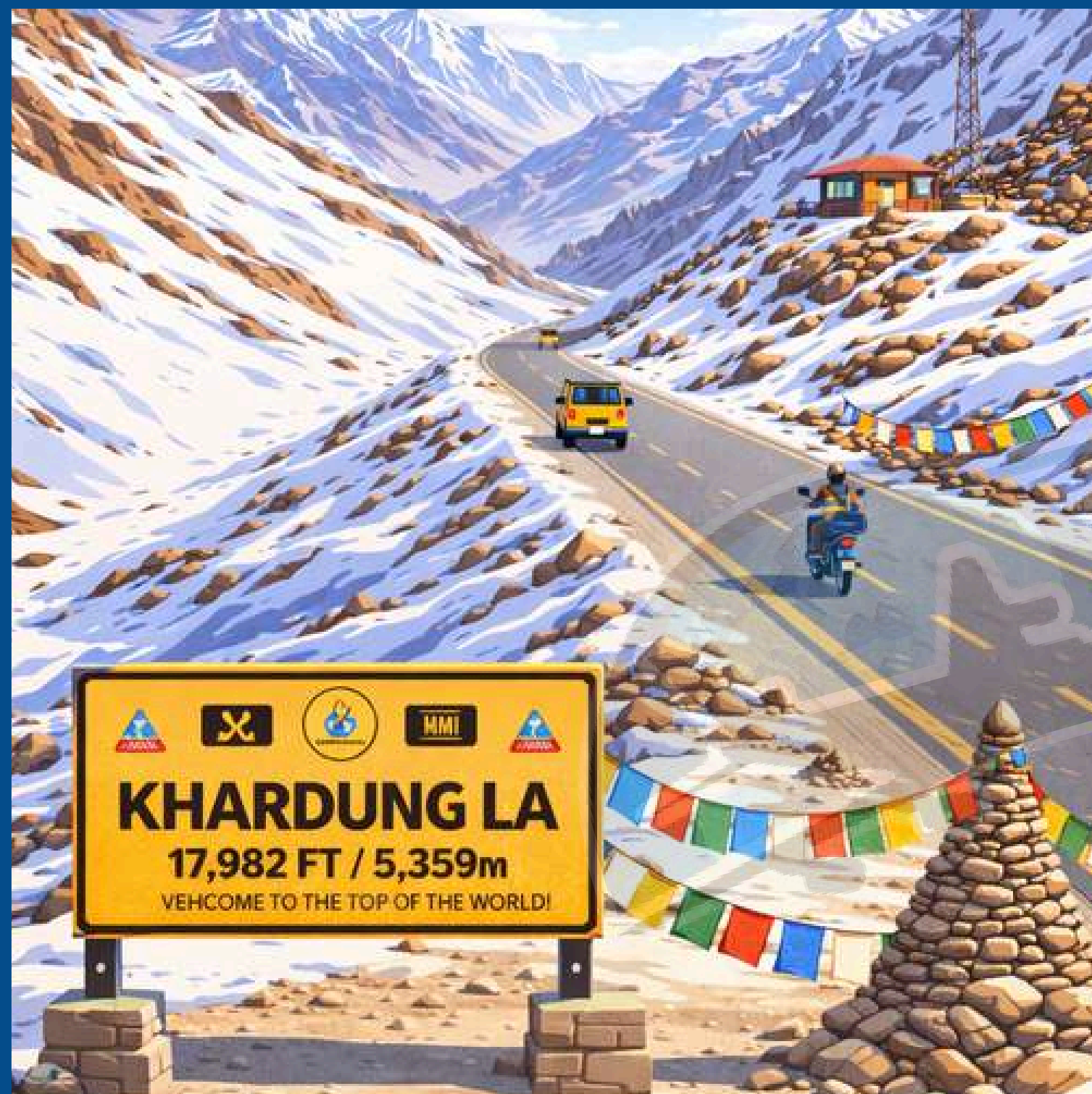


THINGS TO DO IN LEH-LADAKH
